

Day 1 and 2: DEPART from your Gateway City. On your overnight flight to Tel Aviv you will enjoy dinner, breakfast and the movie of the evening. Upon arrival in the afternoon you will transfer to your hotel for dinner. The evening is free for rest as you prepare for the exciting days ahead.

## Day 3: BETHLEHEM

Begin the day with a reflective moment at the Wall. Visit Tent of Nations and a refugee camp in Bethlehem. This afternoon travel to Bethlehem and visit Shepherd's

Field where the angels first sang "Glory to God in the Highest." Visit the Church of the Nativity and kneel at the star which marks the birth of our Savior.

### Day 4: MASADA/QUMRAN/DEAD SEA

Enjoy a free day in Bethlehem or the Dead Sea Day Option. This morning we visit Herod's ancient fortress of Masada, built high atop a mountain on the edge of the Dead Sea. This afternoon visit Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. End the day with time for floating in the Dead Sea. (Optional, \$49)

## Day 5: CAESAREA/MEGIDDO/TIBERIAS

Visit Caesarea by the Sea and the Roman Aqueduct. Cross the Valley of Armageddon to visit Tel Megiddo. Continue to Tiberias, on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

# Day 6: DAN/CAESAREA PHILIPPI

Journey to the northernmost part of Israel to Tel Dan and the beautiful site of natural springs where Peter answered Jesus' question, "Who do you say I am?" with the affirmation, "You are the Christ." A view of Mt. Hermon, the region's highest peak, recalls the words of the Psalmist.

#### Day 7: GALILEE

Begin the day at the Mt. of Beatitudes listening again to The Sermon on the Mount. Visit Tabgha, the site of the famous miracle, and the Church of the Loaves and Fishes. Hear the words of Jesus to Peter, "Feed my sheep," as you visit the Primacy of Peter Church. In the afternoon, see the 1<sup>st</sup> century boat before boarding a boat to cross the Sea of Galilee. Visit the Biblical city of Capernaum and see the old synagogue and the house of Peter's mother-in-law. Visit the newly excavated town of Migdal.

# Day 8: SEPPHORIS/NAZARETH/JORDAN RIVER/JERICHO

Walk the ancient streets of Sepphoris, home of Mary's parents, Anne and Joachim, and the site of the "Mona Lisa of the Galilee," an intricate and well- preserved mosaic floor. Visit Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus. At the Jordan River take time to renew your baptismal vows. In Jericho see Mt. of Temptation.

## Day 9: MT of OLIVES

Visit Bethany and the tomb of Lazarus. Stand on the Mt. of Olives overlooking the Kidron Valley and the walled city of Jerusalem. Walk the Palm Sunday path to Dominus Flavit and the Garden of Gethsemane and visit the Church of All Nations built over the Rock of Agony. Visit the House of Caiaphas, the High Priest, where Jesus was held and Peter denied Him.

### Day 10: OLD CITY - JERUSALEM

Walk the Via Dolorosa (The Way of the Cross), and visit the Pool of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church. Proceed to the Antonia Fortress where the crown of thorns was placed on Jesus' head and take time at the Stations of the Cross for prayer and reflection. Enter the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Take time for prayer at the Western Wall. Visit the Rabbi Teaching Steps and see the Dome of the Rock.

### Day 11: WORSHIP/MUSEUM

After a relaxed morning, worship at St. George's Cathedral. This afternoon visit the Israel Museum, seeing the Shrine of the Book and the model of 1<sup>st</sup> century Jerusalem.

**Day 12:** Travel to Tel Aviv to board night the flight to the USA. Arrive home with a treasure of memories.

You will see all of the above sites during your pilgrimage. Flexibility in the itinerary may be necessary due to unforeseen circumstances such as airline, hotel schedules, and local conditions.

**AGREEMENT:** Registration constitutes acceptance of this agreement by the passengers.

PAYMENT: A \$500 per person deposit is required for registration. Registrations postmarked by April 1st will receive\$100 Early Registration Savings. Receive Dead Sea Day Option FREE if paid in full by Memorial Day. Full payment is due 130 days before departure. Full payment must accompany registrations inside 130 days of departure. Registrations made less than 35 days before departure require a \$75 Late Registration Fee. Late payments will be charged a \$50 late fee. In an effort to maintain lower costs credit cards are not accepted. Canceled checks serve as receipt of payment. Travel Insurance is recommended and information will be provided upon registration.

**AIRLINES**: Air transportation will be provided using economy class aboard IAATA and ARC carriers with APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, unchangeable tickets for groups of 10 or more with the same itinerary. Flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. *Alpha Christian TourS, Inc.* accepts no responsibility for airline delays and will not reimburse any expenses caused by such delays. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded after being purchased.

**CANCELLATION FEES**: 100% of tour cost is refundable by the Optional Travel Insurance Program, provided the premium has been paid and the reason for cancellation is insurable. The following cancellation fees apply to those who do not take Travel Insurance. Up to 130 days before departure  $\sim$  \$75 and any airline penalties. Thereafter, you will be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room plus any airline penalties and the following charges apply: 129 - 100 days  $\sim$  \$500. 99 - 65 days  $\sim$  35% of total trip cost. 64 - 36 days  $\sim$  50% of total trip cost. 35 days to departure  $\sim$  100% trip cost. No refund for any service not used. Travel Insurance is recommended.

+ACCOMMODATIONS: Hotel rooms are based upon double occupancy. ACTS will provide single rooms at an additional charge of \$100 per night if available. If itinerary changes necessitate extra nights there will be an additional charge (Single  $\sim$  \$125, Double  $\sim$  \$85). Single rooms are often smaller than double rooms.

TRACY RADOSEVIC (www.tracyrad.com) is an internationally-acclaimed freelance storyteller who has traveled all over the United States and several foreign countries performing, teaching, preaching, and leading retreats. A longtime member of the Network of Biblical Storytellers International (www.nbsint.org), she served as editor of their bi-monthly newsletter, The Biblical Storyteller, for eight years and is now the dean of their Academy for Biblical Storytelling. Tracy has a Master's Degree in Religious Education from Duke Divinity School, an M.A. in Storytelling from East Tennessee State University, and a Doctor of Ministry in "Spirituality for Transforming Community" from Wesley Theological Seminary where, along with the Ecumenical Institute of Theology in Baltimore, she is now an adjunct professor.

A frequent response I get after telling a biblical story is something along the lines of, "What a great script! Did you write that?" Many are astounded to find out that, not only did I not write it, but, it's quite close to the "script" found right in their own Bibles! What's going on here? Probably several things. But one important element is that when I learn a new biblical story I do more than memorize it; in fact, I do more than "internalize" it ... I embody it with my whole being—physically, intellectually, emotionally, spiritually. It comes from an incarnational theology that believes these stories—and the book from which they come—are already alive and truly the Living Word of the People of God. My job is to respect, maintain, and communicate them in that form. The result? The word made flesh.

Peggy, a recent participant, had this to say about her experience: "Each time someone asks me about our trip, I am at a loss for words. There is just no simple answer. The blessings from it just continue. What I do know is, each time I spotted another pilgrimage listening to their guide rattle on about historical/biblical facts I thought, 'Oh, you poor pilgrims ... you don't have Tracy, the biblical storyteller.' What you added to my experience is beyond words!"

My first trip to Israel/Palestine was a life-changing experience for me. Walking the land, smelling the aromas, seeing the sites, and meeting the people had a visceral impact on me. Continuing to visualize, ever since, the land of our ancestors-in-the-faith has provided an ongoing source of deep spiritual formation for me. Subsequent pilgrimages to Israel/Palestine have included a biblical storytelling focus that has transformed this land—which I could already see in my mind's eye—into a fully-embodied adventure for me. I now have a profoundly personal relationship with this place and its people because I haven't just seen sites, but I have experienced their embodied stories in a uniquely powerful way.

And just like the Ginsu knives ... there's more! As my number of trips to the Holy Land has grown, I've felt an increasing need to also shed a light on issues of justice. I want those who travel with me to get a "front row seat" to what life is really like for the inhabitants of this land we call "holy." These facts and insights are a crucial part of the spiritual pilgrimage experience, both in real time and, more importantly, for how we live out our lives of faith once we return home. So, in addition to visiting sites, I'm delighted to have added opportunities to meet with and talk to local residents. I would love to provide just such an all-round experience for YOU!

We've all heard biblical stories before but what better place to experience them than in the land of their origins? I promise you that your relationship with the Bible and its people, both ancient and current, will never be the same again!
